B. INFORMATION ABOUT THE COURSE

Diploma in Lab Technician (LT)

It is a full time two years programme, Diploma in Lab Technician (LT) from State Medical Faculty Lucknow Uttar Pradesh.

This Course is recognized by Uttar Pradesh State Medical Faculty Lucknow Letter No. $-1504/71 - 4-2020 - N - 8/2016 20^{th}$ November 2020.

<u>1. Orientation & Probation of First Three Months:</u>

The students during this period will familiarize themselves with the laboratory routine, equipments, instruments and institute procedures. Classes, lectures and discussions in different departments of laboratory like Hematology, Clinical Chemistry, Microbiology, Parasitology and Blood Banking will be conducted. After this period, students will be assessed to see if she / he have the aptitude and capability of completing the course. Students who will be found unsuitable will be asked to leave.

2. Training Period:

Students completing the probation period successfully will be allowed to continue training. During this period, besides lectures, discussions on above subjects, Serology, Immunology and Histopathology procedure will also be included. The students will be on rotation schedule for their practical experience. They can be posted in any of the shifts (Morning / Evening / Night). Students will receive orientation in different section of department to integrate theoretical and practical knowledge. The final examination will be conducted by the UP State Medical Faculty Lucknow.

The Diploma course in Lab Technician shall be of two years.

D. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The curriculum designed for this course will help the students to develop physical, mental, spiritual and professional qualities to be a good technician and a good citizen. It is based on sound educational principles, which will enable the students to gain scientific knowledge and technical skills in the medical field of laboratory. This programme helps the students in their personal and professional growth. This will motivate the students to stand on their feet.

E. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years, by 30th December of the current year.
- The minimum educational qualification is 10+2 (Science PCB/PCM only) passed or its equivalent. All the certificates (10+2) will be verified by the faculty and the certificate should be valid.
- Candidate should be unmarried.
- Physically and mentally fit to undergo the training.

Note: Admission of students shall be once in a year.

F. MODE OF APPLICATION

- DMLT application form and prospectus shall be issued from the office of the School of St. Joseph's Paramedical Institute, Ghaziabad on payment of Rs. 350/- in person or Rs. 400/- by demand draft in favour of St. Joseph's Paramedical Institute Payable at Ghaziabad, Mariam Nagar, Meerut Road, Ghaziabad UP 201003.

- g) Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical officer it is compulsory.

I. <u>REJECTION OF ADMISSION FORM</u>

The admission form can be rejected due to any of the following reasons:

- 1. The St. Joseph's Paramedical Institute does not recognize the qualifying examination as minimum qualification.
- 2. The form is incomplete or the required documents are not attached or photographs are not affixed and/or enclosed.
- 3. The admission form is not signed by the candidate himself or herself.
- 4. Those who are enrolled for others academic studies in these years are illegible for this course.

J. INTERVIEW AND SELECTION

- The date for the written test and interview will be intimated through a letter / phone call or E-mail. Please enquire if you don't get the letter by 31/07/2025
- The name of the candidates selected for Entrance Exam and interview, will be displayed at the entrance of the St. Joseph's Paramedical Institute.
- Eligible candidates will appear for an entrance examination (Written Test) of one hour duration, questions from English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and General Knowledge. There will be an interview after written test for those who have done the written examination satisfactorily.
- Selection and admission will be based on merits of qualifying examination Written test and personal interview.
- The decision of the interview board of the institution will be final and binding.
- Preference will be given the candidates from UP State and of Christian minority group.
- Medically and psychologically fit candidates are eligible for the course.

ADMISSION DAY:

The admission day will be informed through a letter, phone call or E-mail.

• The seats of students who do not take admission on the admission day will be given to the waiting list candidates.

- The Selected candidates who are willing to join the course shall report to the admission office and are requested to get the original certificate verified on the same day and have to confirm the seat by depositing Rs. 10,000/- in cash only this money will be adjusted for the medical checkup, immunization, text book, uniform, etc. The 1st year fee should be paid on the day of admission. The money deposited will not be refunded if the candidate does not join or discontinues his / her course liable to pay the full fee to the institution.
- Selected candidates will have to undergo a complete physical examination and only those found fit would be selected for the course.
- If any candidates discontinue his/her course after commencement of classes will be liable to pay the full fee of the course to the institution.
- Hostel accommodation is providing only for the female students if they want.
- Female students those who stay in the hostel has to pay for the mess and hostel. They should abide with the rules and regulations of the hostel as decided by the management.

• The date of commencement course shall be informed to the selected candidates.

L. RULES & REGULATION

- The students are directly under the control and direction of the Principal of the St. Joseph's Paramedical Institute.
- Students are expected to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the School. Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- The students' performance will be evaluated periodically especially before promotion or appearance for the Examination.
- The students will be appearing for the examinations conducted by the UP State Medical Faculty, at the end of each year. For the examination, students must

obtain a minimum of 50% marks in the final examination and a minimum attendance of 75%.

- All the students must wear the prescribed uniform of the school and hospital, while they are on duty and in the class room.
- Students, whose conduct, attendance or performance in theory or clinical field is found not satisfactory, will not be allowed to attend the UPSMF examination.
- Students should be courteous and considerate to the patients, visitors, the public, authorities, and all the health team members. They should impart compassionate love through their words and deeds and provide quality service. Students shall maintain a high standard of conduct.
- The college authority reserves the right to promote or terminate a student, based on their performance.
- Students abstaining from classes/duty or from hostel without prior permission from principal or her deputies will be guilty of the misconduct.
- Visiting the Students: Students those who staying in the hostel will be allowed to meet visitors only with the permission from the principal. Only those visitors approved by the parents will be allowed to meet them. Taking visitors to the hostel room or any other section of the hostel considered a serious offence. Visiting hours is from 09:00 am to 05:00 pm.
- Students those who do not resided in the hostel are to submit their mobile phone in the office while entering in the college campus.
- College hours is from 08:30 am to 04:00 pm with one hour lunch break.
- Wandering in the college campus in groups after college hours is strictly forbidden.
- Students are allowed to have 63 holidays including gazetted holidays, sick leave and preparatory leave per year. Religious sisters are expected to make their retreat during their annual leave.

- Students should have medical examination in the first year. If a student is found medically unfit, she/he will be required to leave. All medical expenses must be met by the student. Any student suffering from a serious illness requiring long rest is sent home for recuperation. In case of need, the student period will be extended to another academic year.
- Students will be dismissed at any time for misconduct, disobedience, in efficiency or repeated serious negligence of duty.
- Students are forbidden to accept gift or hospitality of any kind from patients or their attendants.
- Students will be asked to replace of compensate for loss or damage caused to equipment's.
- The institution takes no responsibility for loss of students' jewellery, personal articles or money. They should keep it safely.
- Marriage is not permitted during the course of study.
- Students are not allowed to use mobile phones during class hours and duty times.
